DIRECTIONS FOR USE

FOR APPLICATION TO PONDS, LAKES, FISHERIES AND ORNAMENTAL BODIES OF WATER.

IMPORTANT: DO NOT APPLY THIS PRODUCT TO WATER INTENDED FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION. DO NOT USE THIS PRODUCT FOR STREAMS, RIVERS OR OTHER BODIES OF WATER, WHICH ARE NOT UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE USER. Apply either directly from container along shoreline or pour from a slow-moving boat. Wind and water currents will slowly disperse and mix Black Pond Dye uniformly throughout the entire body of water. Black Pond Dye can also be applied using a hand-held "Hudson-type" pressure sprayer. Use caution in windy conditions. For best results, apply early in the spring and throughout the season as color intensity indicates.

RECOMMENDED RATES

Apply 22 ounces (650 ml) per acre-foot* of water.

In bodies of water over four feet deep: Determine the initial number of ounces of Black Pond Dye to apply by multiplying the surface acres of the body of water by 4. Once dye has been applied and dispersed, color intensity can be increased by adding additional Black Pond Dye, if desired.

In bodies of water less than four feet deep: Determine the initial number of ounces of Black Pond Dye to apply by multiplying the surface acres of the body of water by the average depth. Once dye has been applied and dispersed, color intensity can be increased by adding additional Black Pond Dye, if desired.

*Recommendations are based on acre-feet of water. One acre-foot is the quantity of water that would cover one surface acre to a depth of one foot. One acre-foot of water is approximately 326,000 gallons.

STORAGE AND CONTAINER DISPOSAL

Store above 32°F. Store this product in a dry place, in original container only. Keep lid tightly closed. Keep away from open flame or intense heat. Triple rinse container and offer for recycling or dispose of in accordance with federal, state and local authorities.
